

PUZZLE SOLUTION - ICC INSIDER February 2006

1. An injury identifiable to a specific part of the body and occurring during the course of a single work shift is a TRAUMATIC injury, which would be filed on form CA-1.
2. A medical condition produced by the work environment over a period longer than one work shift is an OCCUPATIONAL ILLNESS, which would be filed on form CA-2.
3. A SCHEDULE AWARD is compensation benefits payable for the permanent loss or loss of use of specified members, functions, and organs of the body.
4. CONTINUATION OF PAY is paid by the employer for up to 45 calendar days only in connection with traumatic injuries.
5. If an employee uses sick or annual leave due to an on-the-job injury, the leave can be restored and compensation paid instead through the LEAVE BUYBACK process.
