The Defense Logistics Agency currently has employment opportunities for civilians in 18 foreign countries and 4 non-foreign overseas locations. Accepting employment overseas can provide a unique opportunity for you and your family to experience other cultures. Living and working overseas is another way to observe and contribute to the Agency's mission and provides you a broader perspective of DLA's support to the warfighter along with the chance to see the world. As an added incentive, in accordance with federal regulations, DLA provides allowances to supplement your living expenses while stationed overseas.

USAJOBS is the official site to access DLA overseas job announcements and includes a feature which allows you to build a profile by specific criteria (i.e., location, job category, series or agency). When positions are advertised that match your job search criteria, you will receive automatic email alerts.

To create a "My USAJOBS" account, log on at <http://www.usajobs.gov> and select the "Info Center" tab at the top. Under "Career Exploration" along the left, a step-by-step tutorial on how to build the perfect search is provided. If you have an existing account, you may choose to edit and include overseas locations.
