USAJOBS Redesign

USAJOBS is the primary website used by the Defense Logistics Agency to post vacancy announcements. Effective January 23, 2010, USAJOBS will have a new look. It will be redesigned to reflect streamlined and simplified reforms, which include moderating colors, consolidating content, removing redundancies, and adding quick links to key pieces of the site such as job search and account access.

There will only be three tabs at the top of each page instead of the current six, and each tab will have headers with drop down menus and sub menus for navigation. These three navigation menus will be constant throughout the site so you can access and maneuver more easily within USAJOBS.

In addition, you can access or create an account from within the same navigation throughout the site. You can also access quick job search boxes and links from the upper right hand corner of most pages.
