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USAJOBS Technical Issues Resolved

In early October, USAJOBS, the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) website used to advertise all Federal job vacancies, underwent a major upgrade. The site came back on-line October 11th, however following the upgrade the USAJOBS website experienced technical problems that limited access and use of the site, frustrating potential applicants.

The major USAJOBS issues have now been resolved. However, because of the earlier USAJOBS instability, **DLA has extended all open vacancy announcements until COB Tuesday, October 25th at the earliest to ensure potential applicants have an adequate opportunity to apply.**

The USAJOBS website is <http://www.usajobs.gov>. OPM recommends that account holders update their user profiles, review any uploaded resumes or supporting documentation, and check application status. And as a reminder, job search email agents established prior to October 11th must be recreated.

The OPM USAJOBS website will be monitored daily and if additional problems surface, the DLA Human Resources organization will make further adjustments as necessary

The technical issues received considerable media attention, and OPM has worked hard to communicate status to their customers. To receive and respond directly to user feedback, OPM created a monitored USAJOBS Facebook page that can be linked to from the USAJOBS home page. It also includes a recent statement by the OPM Director about the technical issues.
