

## Sample of DLA Training Acquisition Courses

<b>Buying Green: A Multifunctional Approach to Pollution Prevention</b>	<b>2 days</b>
This workshop provides an overview of Federal pollution prevention initiatives and how they relate to the Department of Defense (DOD) acquisition process.	
<b>Contract Pricing</b>	<b>2 days</b>
This workshop provides instruction about the techniques and procedures used in the Department of Defense (DOD) contract pricing practices.	
<b>Contracting Officer's Representative (COR)</b>	<b>5 days</b>
This course provides an introduction to the duties and responsibilities of a Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) and emphasizes the functions of the COR as a liaison between the contracting officer and the contractor. There are two major areas of concentration within this course; COR appointment and COR responsibilities. This course is designed for anyone who has recently been assigned or may be assigned COR responsibilities.	
<b>Contracting Overview</b>	<b>5 days</b>
This course encompasses the entire contracting process from receipt of a purchase requisition through contract completion. Participants are introduced to the organization and utilization of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and the DOD Supplement (DFARS), as well as ethics and basic contract law. The course is designed for individuals who work with Acquisition rather than in Acquisition.	
<b>Performance-Based Services Acquisition (PBSA)</b>	<b>4 days</b>
This workshop leads students through a logical sequence of actions or phases starting with identifying a need; conducting market research assessing appropriateness; preparing the solicitation package and
